

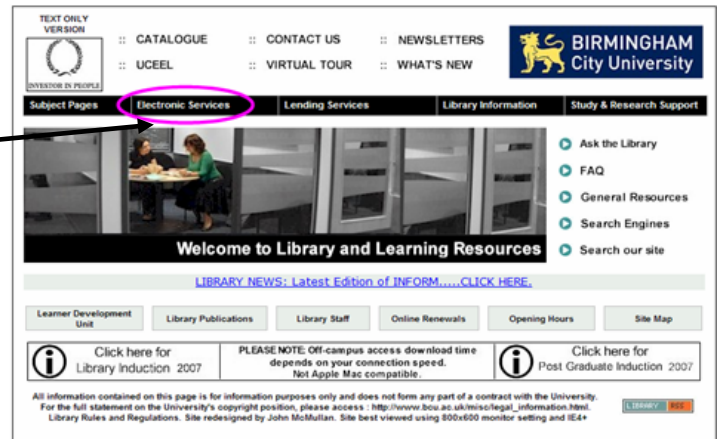
# ACCESSING Ebsco Databases

(Inc. CINAHL Plus with FullText, Medline, International Bibliography of the Social Sciences, PsycINFO)

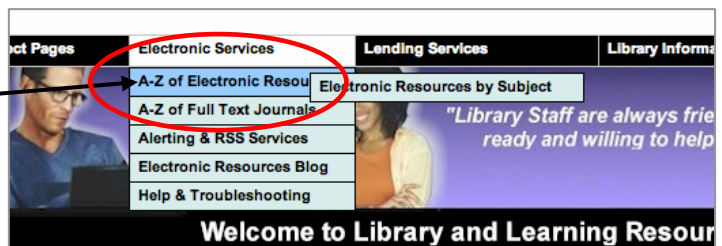


1. In your browser (Internet Explorer, Netscape, Safari, Firefox etc), go to the Library Home Page, <http://library.bcu.ac.uk/>

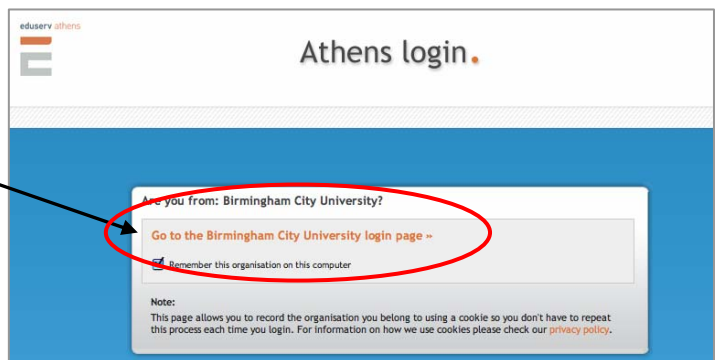
2. Move the mouse pointer over **Electronic Services**



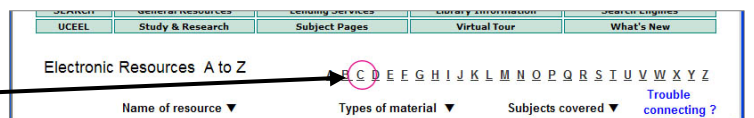
3. Click on **A-Z of Electronic Resources**



4. Click on [Go to the Birmingham City University login page](#)



5. Click on "C" and then scroll down the page to **CINAHL Plus with FullText** (or "M" for Medline, etc)



6. Click on **CINAHL Plus with FullText**

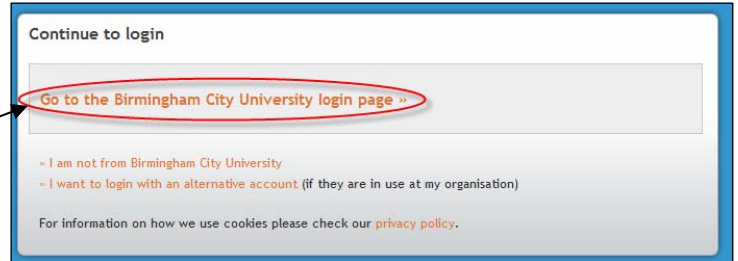
## Off-campus access (Using a Birmingham City University Athens Username)

Follow Steps 1 – 6 on the previous page and when you click on [CINAHL Plus with FullText](#) follow Steps 7 – 8 below.

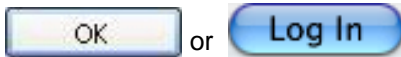
On the first occasion you access the Ebsco databases you will need to download a cookie". Providing your security settings do not delete cookies at the end of a session this should be a one-time download and in future you can access Athens protected resources without the need to download the cookie again.
